Please avoid the following dates and seasons where our Officiating Ministers may be away and/or we are having church level events.

The rest of the dates (including public holidays with the exception of those above) throughout the year are available for selection, but do try to avoid dates when there are church/congregational level events.

Both Sundays and Saturdays are available for weddings. However Sunday is given with priority for couples who attend Saturday services. As most of our officiating ministers are also serving in the Sunday service, we will suggest all Sunday church weddings to be held after 3pm to allow officiating ministers ample time for travelling after the church service.

You may request for a minister of your choice to officiate your wedding. However, this is subjected to the approval from the Pastoral Executive Office. Once a wedding date is confirmed, an email notification will be sent to the couple. The assign officiating minister will meet up with the couple some 2 months prior to the wedding date for briefing on E-filing with ROM and church wedding ceremony.

Do your best to avoid dates where we conduct church level Water Baptism and Membership Class.
