The habits of tithing and giving help us remember God's provision and generosity in our lives.

How do we live continually in the empowerment of the Holy Spirit? 	 Reiterate the importance and role of the Holy Spirit for Christian living. Outline why we need the Holy Spirit's empowerment for our personal relationship with God and our service to Him. Give handles on how believers can keep in step with the Spirit and be empowered on a daily basis. 	We need the power of the Holy Spirit to live a godly life, to build up the Church using the gifts of the Spirit and to fulfil the Great Commission. We live in the empowerment of the Spirit continuously when we keep in step with the Spirit and choose to yield to Him daily.

We serve the local church because we recognize that God primarily uses the church for His redemptive purposes and has called us to follow His ways in serving sacrificially.
7. What is the significance of the Holy Communion?	 Why do we take the Holy Communion? What does the Bread and the Cup mean? How should we take the Holy Communion? 	 Outline reasons why the Holy Communion is an important sacrament for believers and the symbolism of the elements. Highlight the inner heart posture we should have as we partake in the Holy Communion. 	By taking the Holy Communion with other believers, we look back and remember Christ's death and resurrection. Beyond that, we also look forward to and anticipate His eventual return.

To handle relational challenges, we need to be willing to extend forgiveness and seek to make peace with others.
